SBDM Minutes
June 21, 2017

- We have a new Guidance Counselor, Rian Embry.

- The CCR rate is now 100.

- Mallory Kubala came in third in the state with her picture. She will bring the picture in and give it to school.
- Mr. Brewer would like to have an open house for the public on August 4th to showcase the new addition, before the green & white football game, but we will have to wait to make sure the construction is complete.

Public Comment

KHSAA, Band and EOP

- There was a meeting with Ron Kinmon, Ryan Kellinghaus, Barbie Lukens and Steven Schwartz about the EOP. It was decided that Marching and Pep Band would be included in EOP since there wasn't a grade connected to these, but not concert band. When they met, they decided that coaches may require athletes to attend practice or games, but they could not dress or play in the game.

Student Achievement Report

- Julie Rubemeyer reported on the summer SIG Novice Reduction Program. It is going well. They started with 19 students and are now up to 25 students in attendance. The students must meet goals.

Old Business

- Erin Goetz mentioned having a consistent parent letter for 8th graders taking high school classes. This letter/agreement would explain the policy and criteria for students taking Spanish I and Algebra I in middle school. Since Ms. Goetz is out of town, this will be moved to next month's meeting.
- Mr. Wolf said he would look into the possibility of adding to the board policy that requires booster members to have background checks to work games (the same as people wanting to chaperone).
- There is no word on the SIG Grant as yet.
- The Dance Policy was discussed. Middle School students can not leave early unless picked up and signed out by a parent or guardian. High School students must stay until one hour before the dance ends before they can leave.

Angie Buschle made a motion to accept the first reading of the Dance Policy. Barb Lund seconded the motion. The motion carried.

- We still have another year left on Ten Marks. Maybe Lincoln would like to use it while we use Alex.

Barb Lund made a motion to extend the meeting. Angie Buschle seconded the motion. The motion carried.

New Business

- We have a new position, a Blended Learning Media Specialist, and a Biology position to fill.
- There is a new Civics Test requirement for all students to pass to graduate. It is very similar to the test immigrants must pass to become citizens of the United States.
- Mr. Kellinghaus said he would like to change the requirements to walk at graduation. He does not want any students in Daytona or students on Performance Based to walk at graduation. He wants students to want to work their way out of Daytona, and this would be a good reason.
- We need to set dates for Teacher and Department SBDM Money to be spent in July.

Budget Report

- The budget was presented, but there has not been any money spent at this time. We need to review the amounts we give to teachers and departments, and make sure we want to keep it the same as last year.
